POLICIES

If any injury (no matter how minor) has occurred prior to dance class, notify the teacher of the extent of injury and any recommendation by the doctor.

Small children should use the restroom before class begins. **All students must be toilet trained!**

Bring proper shoes to each lesson. Wear suggested dance attire to ensure ease of movement. Label all attire/dance shoes with student's name. Jewelry kept to a bare minimum. No hoop earrings.

No gum, candy, or cough drops while dancing. Hair must be secured away from face. Dance skirt is allowed over leotard.

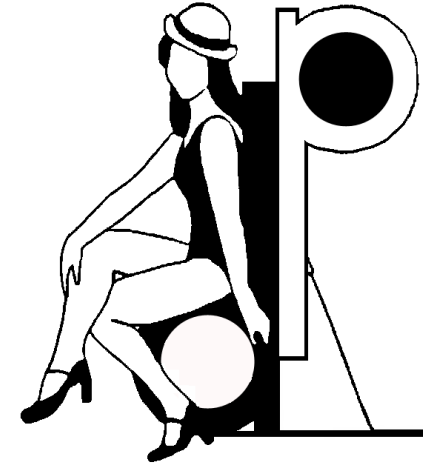
"Observation Day" is schedule for the end of each ten week session which parents are encouraged to see dancer's progress.

DANCE ATTIRE

Preschool: Same as ballet for girls or ballet for boys. Both ballet and tap shoes needed.

Girls Ballet/Tap: Classical black short sleeve leotard, theatrical pink seamless tights, pink ballet slippers with elastic strap, and black tap shoes.

Jazz: Same attire as ballet, "Dance with DeAnne" tee shirt, bike shorts, or dance spandex pants with black jazz oxford laced shoes. No jazz boots. No jeans!

Boys: "Dance with DeAnne" tee shirt, black shorts/sweats; white socks, black ballet slippers with elastic and black tap laced shoes.

FEE SCHEDULE

Annual registration fee of \$20 (*non refundable*) is due upon enrollment with first tuition payment.

Tuition fee for year of instruction (*early Sept to late May*) as follows:

30 min. class \$270.00 year (*\$90 trimester payment*)

60 min. class \$540.00 year (*\$180 trimester payment*)

90 min. class \$810.00 year (*\$270 trimester payment*)

Trimester payments are due by the first lesson of each (10) ten week session (*September, December, March*).

Dance classes are continuous and students are expected to participate in all three ten week sessions (30 weeks total).
